

This year too it is being held at the garden city of the country, our very own Namma Bengaluru. The venue Nirjhari Conference Centre is located at Carmelaram area of Bengaluru. It is about 45 kms away from the airport and 22 kms away from the city centre. The venue is well connected to public transport systems.

#### **Medical:**

Last few years have been a testimonial of the need for integration among medical practitioners to effectively tackle challenges in healthcare. This is the getting together of all Anthroposophically trained and certified physicians of the region to gather, refresh and delve deep into the journey of healing that they have chosen. The IPMT is nodal for the trainings being conducted for the participants of TOPAM (Training of physicians in Anthroposophic medicine). We also look forward to members who wish to participate in new batches of training.

#### **Pedagogy:**

The partnership between teachers and doctors for salutogenesis and disease prevention is one of the most fundamental understandings we operate from. This time onwards it is a unique opportunity for educators as we are formulating a **5-year** program for teachers, enabling them to be able to generate their own healing curriculum, addressing the ever-increasing challenges in the class room. #### **Psychotherapy:**

The psychotherapist would be conducting their exclusive training modules that are part of their certification process. The topics to be covered in this module would include the planets and their influence on the soul and spirit and more.

#### **Biodynamic Agriculture:**

Biodynamically grown food is filled with life enhancing and healing forces. The program schedule includes Principles of Organic and Biodynamic farming, Biodynamic Preparations and how to use them, BD agriculture Planting calendar, BD compost, Demeter standards and certification, and reading of chapter 4 of the agriculture course.
